1. Preamble





Airport Name	Note
Incheon International Airport (ICN)	The main international airport in South Korea, where most international flights arrive.
Gimpo International Airport (GMP)	Located closer to downtown Seoul, mainly serving domestic flights (including flights to Busan) and a few short-haul international routes.
Gimhae International Airport (PUS)	The main airport for Busan and the southeastern region of Korea, handling both domestic and international flights. It is the closest airport to Haeundae, about 1 hour by bus or taxi.



Visa Requirements for Entry to the Republic of Korea.

Visa-Free Entry

- Nationals from 112 Countries may enter Korea without a visa for short-term visits (usually up to 90 days), depending on their nationality.

K-ETA (Korea Electronic Travel Authorization)

Travelers from visa-waiver countries must apply for K-ETA before

- Processing time: usually within 24 hours

- Validity: 2 years (multiple entry)

Visa Required

Nationals of countries not eligible for visa-free entry of K-ETA must apply for a visa at the Korean Embassy or Consulate in their home country before traveling.

- Required documents typically include an invitation letter from the local organization.
