These EDB's have undergone to various changes and lead towards the new Generation of EDB's which facilitates dissemination of satellite pictures, animations, short-films, ocean state information, disaster information and Disaster warning and alert system in addition to the normal text information.</li> <li>Presently, the mobile services are also playing a major role as the mobile is now being available with most of the fishermen community in the country. Hence, mobile has been used as an effective tool for dissemination of the PFZ advisories directly to the user. ESSO-INCOIS in collaboration with various partners (NGOs, Industry, Government and Private firms) have initiated various mobile based dissemination mechanisms such as Interactive Voice Response System (IVRS), mobile applications viz.
